**Draft Minutes of the meeting of Llanddowror and Llanmiloe Community Council**

**Held in the Llanddowror Meeting Room, Monday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2018.**

- 1. Apologies for absence.** There were none received.
- 2. Declaration of personal interests.** None were declared.
- 3. Discussion on planning application W/37655.**

Cllr Holt as the Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting, and thanked them for coming. He stated that the sole topic for the meeting was planning application W/73655, the proposal for change of use from farmland and to have two gypsy traveller pitches, plus associated dayrooms on a site to the south of Brynhowell, Llanddowror. The Clerk had circulated some information prior to the meeting, and provided maps of the proposed site for review in the meeting. The Chair then opened up the meeting for discussion.

Various comments were expressed, with people stating their initial views, and those they had come to after reading more of the information provided in the application and otherwise. A lengthy discussion followed on from these, but the view was taken that although the Council represented the community, it was important that they hear comments from them directly before coming to a final decision in this situation. It was agreed that this planning application had not been widely publicised, and was not known about, and so therefore the community as a whole deserved a chance to consider it and submit their own views if they wished to CCC.

The Council therefore agreed to jointly host an open evening for discussion with Llanddowror Village Association on Tuesday 28th August in the Meeting Room. During this people would have an opportunity to find out more about and discuss this application, and would be encouraged to put forward their own views directly to CCC. Following on from this the Council would convene and decide upon their formal feedback to CCC. The Clerk would contact CCC to request an extension to the deadline for the Council to respond.

There being no other topic for discussion or decision, the meeting closed at 7.55pm.
