**Minutes of the meeting of Llanddowror and Llanmiloe Community Council**

**Held in the Llanmiloe Resource Centre, Monday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2019.**

Present Cllr Chris Holt in the chair, Cllrs Tony Paradise, Phill Pickersgill, Angela Crewes, Terence Langdon, Sandra Hewens and Gwyn Owen and County Cllr Jane Tremlett..

- 1. To accept apologies for absence.** These were received from Cllr David Howells, who was away.
- 2. To disclose personal and pecuniary interests in the items listed below.** None were declared.
- 3. To review and agree the minutes of the previous meeting** on 11<sup>th</sup> February 2019. These were agreed as a true record – proposed by Cllr Pickersgill, and seconded by Cllr Hewens, and agreed by all, so were duly signed.
- 4. County Cllrs report.**

Cllr Tremlett gave the following updates: The bin bags had been collected – any further incidents should be reported to her. The speed ramps in Llanmiloe had been inspected, and there were some sections displaced and one potentially unsafe one. They would be re-seated, and continue to be monitored for future movement.

The request for gritting along the road through Llanddowror and to Red Roses had been passed to the relevant department. Cllr Tremlett had been informed that the speed check results for Llanddowror had not yet been issued, and that they were to be discussed with the Police and GoSafe. She stated that she would follow up on this to ensure this Council received those results.

It was then reported to Cllr Tremlett that there were issues with blocked drains in Llanmiloe – the details were given and she stated she would pass the concerns on.

Cllr Tremlett then left the meeting.

**5. To receive the following information and decide further actions as required:**

- Meeting Room drainage channel. The additional channel had not yet been done – the Clerk had been chasing but getting no response. The Clerk would continue to chase up on this.
- A477 Junctions meeting. The Clerk had previously circulated the response from the Minister. She provided a draft response to that letter, explaining that it would also go to the other Councils involved for their views, before being sent at the end of the month. The Council agreed that pressure needed to be maintained to highlight the issues.
- Chair plaque – this was postponed until the next meeting.
- Code of Conduct training 14<sup>th</sup> March. Three Cllrs would be attending this. It was agreed to make the payment for this in this meeting.
- Complaint re planning handling. There was no update available on this.

## 6. To discuss new items of business

- There was no new business, but the Clerk took the opportunity at the Chair's request to explain in greater detail about the IRPW allowance.

The Clerk provided a statement of the current finances of the Council, including the planned budget for each heading for reference.. This was agreed as acceptable by all – proposed by Cllr Pickersgill and seconded by Cllr Langdon.
